#### **Product Description**

*DURLAST* is a high quality, high solids drywall primer specifically formulated to fill the pores and equalize the suction difference between gypsum board surface paper and compound. *DURLAST* is to be applied as a first coat to the entire, prepared gypsum board surface and skim coatings, to help minimize most decorating problems, prior to decoration.

#### **Advantages**

DURLAST is a high hide, fast drying, and economical drywall primer that minimizes joint banding and photographing. DURLAST is designed to give you a dry film thickness superior to most high build and paint primers. Due to DURLAST excellent hiding properties, it gives you the versatility to apply over trim. DURLAST can also act as a texture additive, to increase bond, hide, and whiteness to wall and ceiling spray textures.

## **Surface Preparation**

Surfaces shall be clean, dry, and free of grease, wax, dust, concrete releasing agents, and gloss.

- New gypsum wallboard surfaces and accessories should be treated with JOINT BUTTER as per instructions, must be smooth and dry thoroughly prior to DURLAST application.
- Concrete, plaster, and masonry surfaces must be smooth and cured thoroughly, the sealed with DS 750 100% Acrylic Primer/Sealer prior to DURLAST application. Prime rust areas with a rust-inhibiting primer. Allow new concrete to cure for 30 days.
- 3. Painted surfaces should be dulled or apply an appropriate bonding primer prior to DURLAST application.

#### **Product Data**

MATERIAL: Vinyl Acrylic

COLOR: White or Off White. Can be tinted at store level with most color systems to a variety of pastel or mid-tone colors. (Use up to 4 oz. of universal colorant per five gallons.)

PRODUCT SENSITIVITY: Do not apply when temperatures are below 50°F or above 95°F.

MIXING: Mix material thoroughly. If thinning is necessary, do not exceed one pint of clean water per gallon.

### DO NOT OVER-THIN PRODUCT.

APPLICATION: Brush, roller, or airless spray machine. (.75 gpm) using .019-.023 tip and 30 mesh filter

COVERAGE: Approximately 150-300 ft per gallon, depending on surface and equipment. DECORATION: Dries to touch in 30 minutes under 75° F/50% relative humidity conditions.

# NOT INTENDED AS FINAL COAT. SHOULD BE OVERPAINTED WHEN DRY.

STORAGE: Do not store material in direct sunlight, or in tempertures below 32°F.

Good storage conditions will allow up to 12 months shelf life.

#### PROTECT FROM FREEZING.

PACKAGING: 5 gallon pail, 55 gallon drum, and 275 gallon tote.

WARRANTY: If TWI's *DURLAST* fails to perform as specified when applied according to specifications, TWI's liability shall be limited to refund of purchase price with proof of purchase. SAFETY PRECAUTIONS: When dry sanding or spraying, wear eye protection and a respirator that are NIOSH approved.
