Product Description

SPRAY-PREP is a high solids drywall surfacer that is specifically formulated to fill the pores and equalize the porosity difference between the gypsum board surface paper and joint compound. SPRAY-PREP is to be applied as a first coat, to the entire prepared gypsum board surface and skim coatings, to help minimize most decorating problems, prior to texturing and/or painting.

Advantages

SPRAY-PREP is a high hide, fast drying, and economical drywall surfacer that minimizes joint banding and photographing. Because of the solids and superior coverage, a single pass application equals several coats of conventional paint. SPRAY-PREP is designed to achieve a dry film thickness superior to most high build and/or paint primers.

Surface Preparation

Surfaces shall be clean, dry, and free of grease, wax, dust, concrete releasing agents, and gloss.

- New gypsum wallboard surfaces and accessories should be treated with JOINT BUTTER as per instructions, must be smooth and dry thoroughly prior to SPRAY-PREP application.
- Concrete, plaster, and masonry surfaces must be smooth and cured thoroughly, then sealed with DS 750 100% Acrylic Primer/Sealer prior to SPRAY-PREP application.
 Prime rust areas with a rust-inhibiting primer. Allow new concrete to cure for 30 days.

Product Data

MATERIAL: Vinyl Acrylic

COLOR: White. Can be tinted at store level with most color systems to a variety of pastel or

mid-tone colors. (Use up to 4 oz. of universal colorant per five gallons.)

PRODUCT SENSITIVITY: Do not apply when temperatures are below 50°F or above 95°F.

MIXING: Stir material thoroughly. **DO NOT OVER-THIN PRODUCT.**

APPLICATION: Airless spray machine. (1.25 gpm) using .023-.027 tip and 30 mesh filter. COVERAGE: Approximately 150-250 ft² per gallon, depending on surface and equipment. DECORATION: Dries to touch in 30-90 minutes under 75° F/50% relative humidity conditions.

NOT INTENDED AS FINAL COAT. SHOULD BE OVERPAINTED WHEN DRY.

STORAGE: Do not store material in direct sunlight, or in tempertures below 32°F.

Good storage conditions will allow up to 12 months shelf life.

PROTECT FROM FREEZING.

PACKAGING: 5 gallon pail, 55 gallon drum, and 275 gallon tote.

WARRANTY: If *SPRAY-PREP* fails to perform as specified when applied according to specifications, TWI's liability shall be limited to refund of purchase price with proof of purchase.

approved respirator.
